### ENTRY RULES

- All project members and exhibits must follow all Holmes County Jr. Fair General Rules and conform to livestock exhibit health requirements listed previously in this fair book.
- All dogs must be currently licensed by the county.
- All 4-H members enrolled in dog obedience or related dog care project are encouraged to participate in interview judging prior to show. (All 4-H members must be judged to complete project.) Holmes Happy Hounds 4-H Dog Training Club will conduct project judging interviews and obedience judging for county placement.
- Youth do not need to qualify to show at the State Fair. Their entry for State Fair participation must meet the July 2, deadline.
- Holmes Happy Hounds 4-H Dog Training is available to all 4-H members taking a dog project in Holmes County. The first meeting will be the first Saturday of May, at the fairgrounds, from 10:30 AM - 11:30AM.
- Judging will consist of two parts:
  - An interview to determine project grade.
  - The obedience activity.
- Judging is held prior to the Holmes County Fair. County awards and State Fair participants are chosen at this time.
  - Book judging will be Saturday, June 19, 2010 10AM at the fairgrounds.
  - Dog Show for county award winners and State Fair participants will be on Saturday, June 19, 2010 at 10:00 AM at the fairgrounds.
