**ENTRY RULES**

- All project members and exhibits must follow all Holmes County Jr. Fair General Rules and conform to Livestock Exhibit Health Requirements listed previously in the Fair Book.
- All livestock, to be exhibited, must be entered on an entry form by July 1st. 2010 FAIR ENTRIES PROCEDURE: Fair Entry Forms (for pen will be assignments) accepted at the Holmes Co. Fair Grounds Jr. Fair Board Office on the following dates and times:

Mailed entries will not be accepted.

Tuesday .....June 8 .....3:00 - 7:00 PM

Thursday .....June 17 .....3:00 - 7:00 PM

Saturday ..June 26 .....9:00 AM - NOON

Thursday .....July 1 .....3:00 - 7:00 PM

on or before July 1st or space will not be available for exhibit.

Club guidelines must be met to show and sell.

- Livestock member project grades will be determined by an interview evaluation, Skill-A-Thon, covering project book subject matter and basic 4-H/FFA knowledge. All Jr. Fair exhibitors must attend scheduled county judging, if unable to attend, club advisors may evaluate projects. Projects must be evaluated and grade(s) submitted to the Extension Office before the scheduled county judging date. Members who do not attend scheduled county judging are not eligible for Outstanding Market Livestock Awards.
- All Jr. Livestock ewe sheep must be scrappie tagged.
- All Market Lamb projects must be tagged on Saturday, May 22, 2010 between 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. Exhibitor may tag two but may only exhibit and sell one lamb.
- All wethers are to be castrated by cutting or banding and must not have any testicular development. NO PINCHING is allowed.
- Market Lamb classes will be determined upon official weight at weigh-in, from 7:00 PM Sunday, August 15th, 2010.
- All Market Lambs must be slick shorn.
- A sheep's body condition score needs to be a 2 or higher, which is determined by the vet, to allow eligibility to show.

**SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP ENTRY RULES**

- Showmanship classes are divided by age of exhibitor as of January 1st.
  - Beginner 8 thru 12 (First Year of Showing)
  - Junior 11 years and under
  - Intermediate 12 thru 14
  - Senior 15 years and over
- Current year winners of age classes are eligible to show in Supreme Showmanship plus previous years Supreme Showmanship winners.
- First year project members, up to age 12, are encouraged to enter the Beginner's Showmanship class. However, members participating in the Beginner Showmanship class are ineligible to compete in the Junior, Intermediate or Senior classes for the current year, nor are they eligible for Outstanding Market Livestock Award.

**SUPREME SHOWMANSHIP ENTRY RULES**

- If a participant wins their age division, they will move to Supreme Showmanship. If the participant wins Supreme Showmanship, they will continue to show in that class.

1. All lambs will be checked by ultrasound for carcass evaluation. Lambs will have data gathered to determine the top 5 carcass lambs. Scanning will be done Sunday, August 15 th, 2010. Announcement of Champion and other top four lambs will be done the night of the Market Lamb Sale, Thursday, August 19 th, 2010. It is highly encouraged that all the Market Lamb exhibitors participate.
2. Top 5 lamb carcasses receive monetary awards.
3. There must be at least 30 entries by May 22nd, 2010 to have the Carcass Contest.
