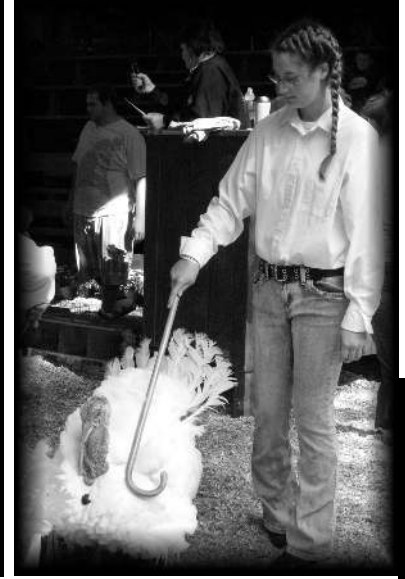
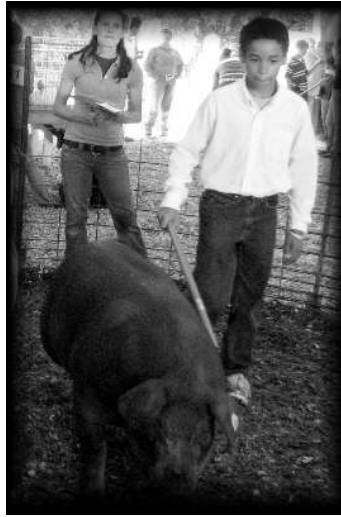

## LITTLE INTERNATIONAL SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

### ENTRY RULES

- Contest is open to top four current showmen in all ten showmanship classes as listed below.
- The previous year's Little International Best Junior Showman and Little International Best Senior Showman will be ineligible for this year unless there is a change in age class.
- Entrants will be judged on their ability to show all different animals by ten individual judges.
- Scoring will be from one to ten in each class. The highest total scoring member will be the winner
- Scores from the "Bonus Round" will be counted only as a tie breaker.
- Follow dress code rules for department represented.

### CLASS SHOWMEN CHOSEN \*see below for Alternates

- Beef Steers or Breeding Heifers:  
One Junior, One Intermediate, Two Senior
- Dairy:  
One Supreme - One Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- Dairy Feeder/Dairy Steers:  
To Be Determined
- Goats:  
Top four from Supreme Showmanship class: Highest placing of: Senior, Intermediate, and Junior members.  
One Junior and one Senior from each.
- Llama:  
Two Senior - Two Junior
- Poultry:  
Two Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- Rabbits:  
One Supreme - One Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- Sheep: One Supreme - One Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- Swine: Two Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- Turkey: Two Senior - One Intermediate - One Junior
- A bonus round will be held. Score from Bonus Round will be used only in the event of a tie.

\*\*In the event that the Senior Champion Showman is chosen as Supreme Showman, the second place senior will be the senior participant and the third place senior will be the First Alternate to be entered into the Little International competition.

In the event that the Intermediate Champion Showman is chosen as Supreme Showman, the second place intermediate will be the intermediate participant and the third place intermediate will be the First Alternate to be entered into the Little International competition.

In the event that the Junior Champion Showman is chosen as Supreme Showman, the second place junior will be the junior participant and the third place junior will be the First Alternate to be entered into the Little International competition.

### AWARDS

Participant ribbons will be awarded to all members in the contest. Placing ribbons of 2nd through 10th places, excluding Best Senior Showman and Best Junior Showman, will be given.

- Open to 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters.
  - All livestock projects in the Jr. Fair are automatically entered, and all animals entered by one club or chapter constitute an exhibit. Only animals under supervision of club leader or assistant may compete.
  - Exhibits are to be completed by 8:00 AM. Monday and are subject to judging from that time through Saturday at 3:00 PM. Awards will be made to club/chapter advisor. Animals removed from exhibit prior to dismissal time without permission of the Fair Board Superintendent will cause forfeiting of award money.
  - The following will be emphasized in judging this contest. General appearance of exhibits, including:
    - Condition of animals and attendants
    - 4-H club/FFA member participation
    - Attractiveness of exhibit
    - Cleanliness of space allotted to exhibitor (Floors, seating area, etc. and orderliness of equipment)
    - Cleanliness of stall - wheelbarrows, sawdust and straw.
- Judges' decision will be final in all cases.

### AWARDS

- Daily - Rotating Banner to be displayed above the previous day large club and small club Herdsman Contest winners.
- A cash award will be presented for the best display in each of the nine livestock categories which include:  
Beef, dairy, sheep, swine, goats, horse, llamas, rabbits, chickens and turkeys.  
A Large Club/Chapter exhibit (6 or more animals) receives a \$20.00 cash award.  
A Small Club /Chapter exhibit (less than 6 animals) receives a \$10.00 cash award.

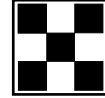
